Coco has bought $10 \times 45 = 450$

Colin has bought $45 \times 10 = 450$

They both have the same amount of sweets.

1.2.21 Secure it

WALT: To be able to multiply a 2 digit number by 10 using place value

Coco is incorrect because she has added 10 to the end of the number 12 rather than multiply by 10 and move the digits one place to the left and putting zero as the place holder.

The answer should be:

$$12 \times 10 = 120.$$
