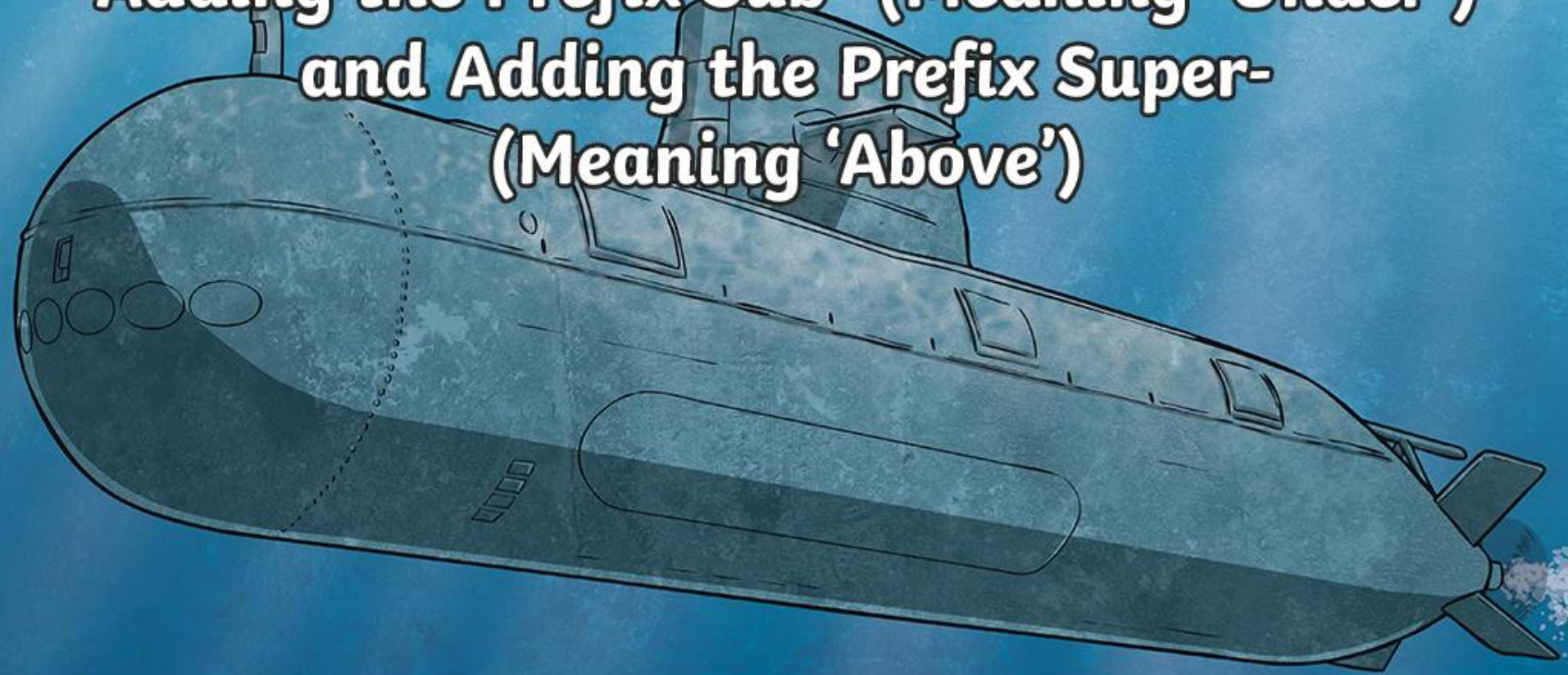


Adding the Prefix Sub- (Meaning 'Under') and Adding the Prefix Super- (Meaning 'Above')



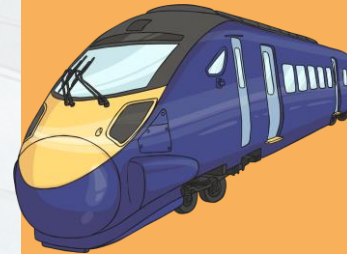

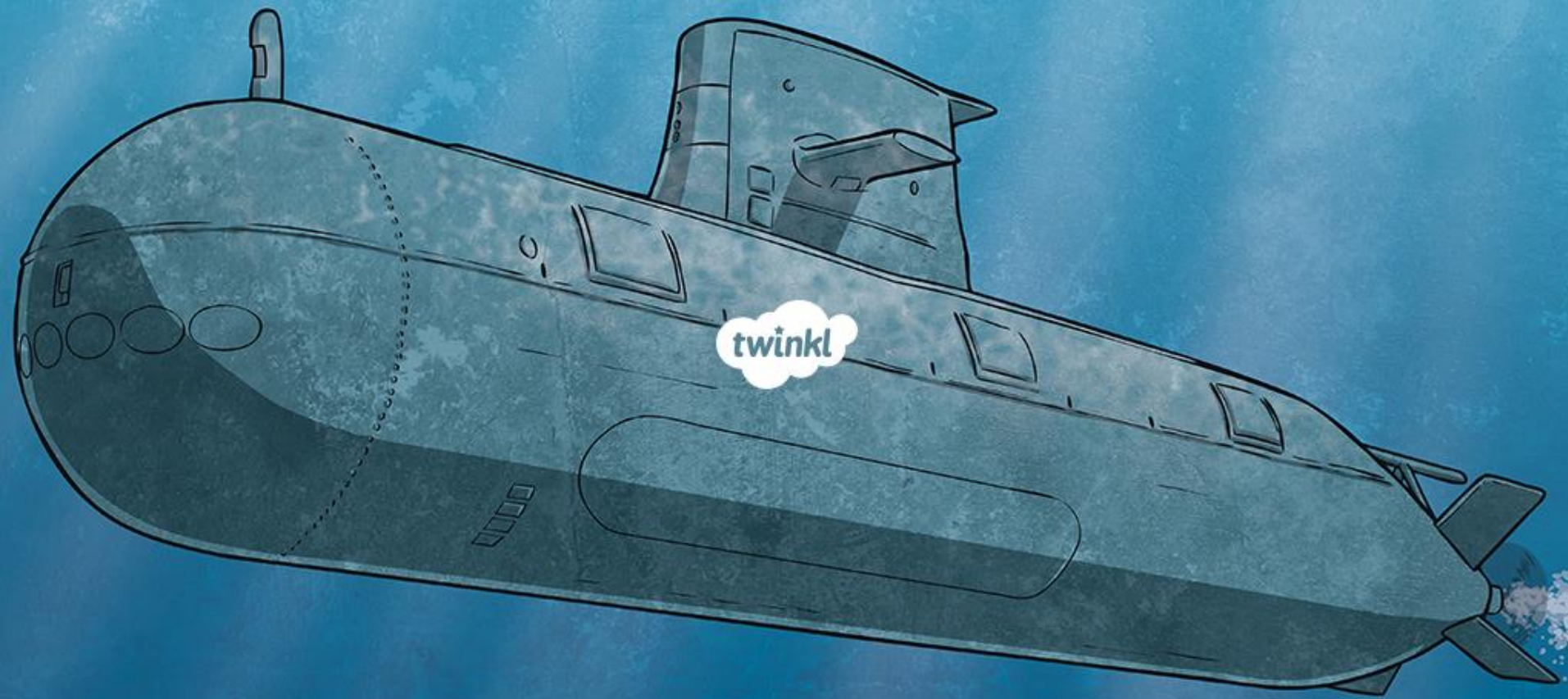
