

WAL to order intervals of time (using clock faces – analogue).

### Do it:

Put the durations of time in order from shortest to longest.

one o'clock to half past one	
35 minutes	
three quarters of an hour	
40 minutes	
25 past 4 to 25 past 5	
Quarter to four to four o'clock	

Can you put the times on these clocks in order?



### Secure it:

Colin says, "I left school at twenty-five minutes to four and arrived home at twenty minutes past four. It took me longer to get home."

Coco says, "I left school at half past three and arrived home at twenty minutes past four. It took me longer to get home."

Who is correct? Explain how you know.

### Deepen it:

**The school show starts at 1 o'clock and finishes at 3 o'clock.**

**Each performer cannot start until the performer before them finishes.**

**Performer 3 will get the longest time.**

**Performer 1 will get the shortest time.**

**Fill out the order of performance so everyone fits.**
