#### SCHOOL GAMES DEBATING

- TEAMS OF 4 FROM Y5/6, WITH POTENTIAL TO INCLUDE FURTHER NUMBERS
- TEAMS DEBATE TOPIC SET BY SGO WITH FELLOW SCHOOLS, STATING THEIR CASE WITH DIFFERING ROLES IN THE TEAM
- WINNERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY A PANEL OF JUDGES WITH DECISION FORMED THROUGH:
- QUALITY OF PROPOSAL (CONTENT AND PRESENTATION)
- RESPONSE TO CHALLENGE (OPPOSING TEAM/FLOOR AUDIENCE/JUDGING PANEL)
- QUESTIONS PROVIDED FROM THE FLOOR

#### **CROSS COUNTRY QUALIFIERS**

- Y3/4/5/6 ATHLETES COMPETE IN AGE AND GENDER SPECIFIC RACES
- Y5/6 RACES HAVE ABILITY TO QUALIFY FOR COUNTY FINALS

### SCHOOL GAMES QUICK STICKS HOCKEY

• 4 PLAYERS IN A TEAM, SQUAD OF 6, TWO BOYS AND TWO GIRLS PER TEAM ON FIELD AT ONE TIME

#### SCHOOL GAMES PANATHLON CHALLENGE

- KS1 & KS2 BOYS AND GIRLS, BETWEEN 6-10 MEMBERS IN A TEAM
- MUST HAVE SPECIAL NEED OR DISABILITY
- CIRCUIT OF INCLUSIVE ACTIVITIES





#### **SCHOOL GAMES ORIENTEERING**

- FOR Y5/6 CHILDREN
- FOR THOSE NOT NORMALLY INVOLVED IN COMPETITIVE SPORT
- TEAMS OF 10 MAXIMUM CHILDREN PER TEAM
- TEAM COMPLETES ORIENTEERING COURSE USING TEAMWORK AND DISPLAYING SKILLS THEY MAY NOT HAVE EXHIBITED PREVIOUSLY

#### **DANCE FESTIVAL**

- OPEN FORMAT FESTIVAL FOR ALL AGES
- DANCES TO BE NO LONGER THAN 4 MINUTES

#### **KS2 DUATHLON**

- FOR CHILDREN ON THE SEND REGISTER, THOSE CHILDREN DIS-ENGAGED WITH SCHOOL, DISENGAGED WITH PE/PHYSICAL ACTIVITY/SPORT, LOW IN CONFIDENCE/SELF-ESTEEM/ABILITY

- TEAMS OF 10 CHILDREN
- CHILDREN COMPLETE A RANGE OF STATIONS IN A CIRCUIT AIMED TO DEVELOP THEIR FUNDAMENTAL SKILLS
- NON-SCORING EVENT, CHILDREN ARE INFORMED OF THEIR INDIVIDUAL SCORE, THESE ARE NOT RECORDED
- FOR CHILDREN OF MIXED ABILITY

- SQUADS OF 12
- PLAYERS COMPLETE A TECHNIQUE BUILDING CIRCUIT OF ACTIVITIES
  FOLLOWED BY MATCHES AGAINST FELLOW SCHOOLS
- OUTDOORS ON GRASS
- NO PRIOR EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

- SQUADS OF 12

  ACROSS THE EVENT GAINING POINTS FOR THEIR SCHOOL
- SCHOOLS COMPETING FOR MEDALS
- ALL ACTIVITIES AIMED TO DISPLAY AND DEVELOP CHILDREN'S SKILLSET

#### **SCHOOL GAMES QUAD KIDS ATHLETICS**

- FOR CHILDREN IN Y3/4
- 4 DISCIPLINE ATHLETICS EVENT- 50M RUN, 400M RUN, MINI-HOWLER THROW. STANDING LONG JUMP
- TEAMS OF EITHER 8 OR 10, EQUAL SPLIT OF BOYS AND GIRLS

#### **FUN RUNS**

- REPLACING THE CROSS COUNTRY FORMAT. CHILDREN COMPLETE AS MANY LAPS AS THEY WISH IN AN ALLOCATED TIME AND WE CALCULATE THE DISTANCES COVERED
- ALL CHILDREN START AND FINISH THEIR RUNS TOGETHER

## VIRTUAL CHALLENGE- RUGBY, NETBALL, HOCKEY, INCLUSIVE, AND STRIKING AND FIELDING

- 5 CHALLENGES FOR A TEAM OF 10
- EACH CHALLENGE WORKS ON KEY SKILLS FOR THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES, BUILDING SKILLS, TECHNIQUES AND CONFIDENT IN THESE SPORTS
- EACH ACTIVITY IS SCORED TO BUILD A TEAM SCORE
- THE TEAM SCORE IS ENTERED INTO THE OVERALL LEADER BOARD FOR ALL PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS
- TOP THREE TEAMS RECEIVE MEDALS, ALL PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE CERTIFICATES
