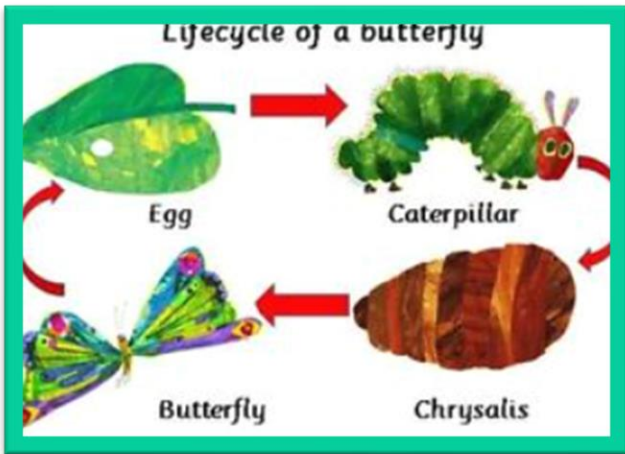

Food Chains

grass, cow, human
plant, insect, bird.

Habitats

habitat – the home that suits an animal or plant.

Microhabitat – a very small habitat e.g. woodlice under stones

plants – cactus desert/oak tree forest

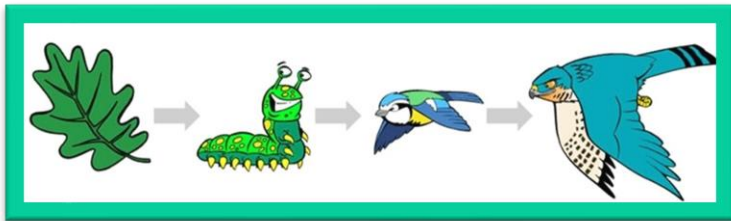
animals – polar bear ice/worm soil/shark ocean

What do animals eat?

plants and other animals

Hibernation

Animals sleep for winter to save energy



Types of animal

invertebrate – don't have a backbone - without shell e.g. jellyfish, insects, worm or with shell e.g. crab

vertebrate – have a backbone e.g. fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals

Types of plant

flowering e.g. flowers, blossom trees

non-flowering e.g. ferns and mosses
