


Hibernation

Types of animal

soil/shark ocean

invertebrate – don't have a backbone - without shell e.g. jellyfish, insects, worm or with shell e.g. crab

habitat – the home that suits an

Microhabitat – a very small habitat

plants – cactus desert/oak tree forest

e.g. woodlice under stones

animals – polar bear ice/worm

vertebrate – have a backbone e.g. fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals

Types of plant

flowering e.g. flowers, blossom trees non-flowering e.g. ferns and mosses
