

In Maple Class

In maple class, children will have a 'challenge reader' which will be in line with the Oxford reading levels. They will be assessed and placed on an appropriate level as follows:



All children will also take home a 'richer reading' book which they can choose themselves from the class book shelf. When reading in school, all children will read their challenge reading book so that we are supported them to make progress, not their 'richer reading' book. They can of course read both books at home.

Books will be changed when they are finished throughout the week and children do not move on to the next level until they are assessed by a teacher as being ready.

Library Book:

The children also visit the library once a week, in the library they can choose any book that they want to bring home. This is for them to just enjoy looking at and can be kept at home as long as they like and brought back when it is finished with. Maple class' library day is on a Monday and they will be allowed to bring a new book home, each time they return one.
