Sculpture – expressing
form through art.

Theme – the big idea or message of
the art.

Content – what is included in the art.

Process – how a piece of art was put
together.

Impact – a strong effect on
something.

Techniques

Cutting – divide into pieces
with a sharp implement.

Joining – link or connect

Shaping – making a form out
of material

Elements of Art

Form – an element of art which is 3-
dimensional and has height, width and
depth.

Texture – what something feels like in
real life e.g. think brushstrokes on a
painting, rough or smooth clay.

Vocabulary

Contrasting – opposite elements are
arranged together e.g. black and
white, thick and thin, smooth and
rough.

Smooth – even and regular, no
bumps or lumps.

Rough – uneven or irregular, bumpy.

Thick – sides of it are far apart.

Thin – sides of it are close together.
