Portrait – a piece of art where a person is the main content.

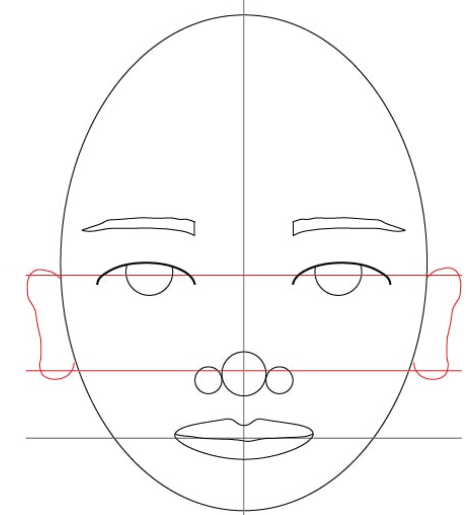
Self-portrait – a piece of art where the artist is the main content.



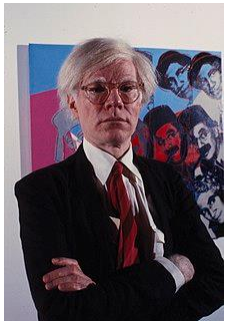
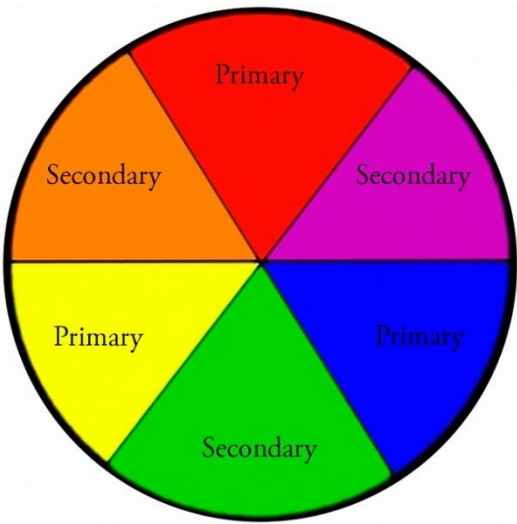

Pure hue



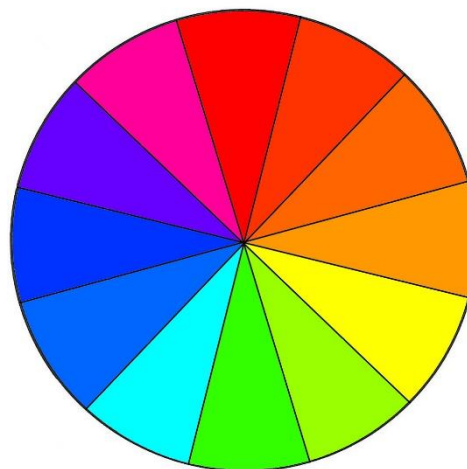
Tints

Elements of Art

Colour – how we describe the way our eyes see light.

Pattern – a repeated, decorative design.

Line – a mark made on a surface that joins different points.

Shape – a 2D area.
