### Physical features:

**Forest** – a large area covered mostly with trees and shrubs.

**Hill** – a naturally raised area of land.

**Soil** – the top layer of the earth where plants grow.

**Vegetation** – plants found in an area of land.



### Human features:

**Village** – a group of houses in the countryside.

**Farm** – an area of land and its buildings used for looking after crops and animals.

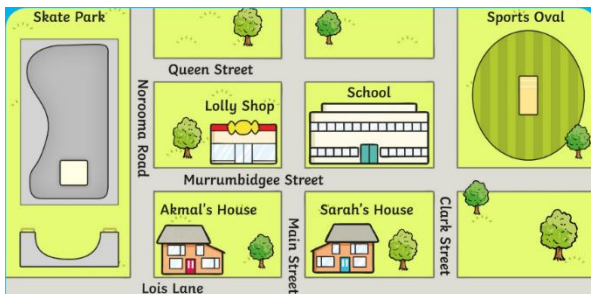
**House** – a building where someone lives.
